## A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to create a southern division in the Northern Judicial District of Illinois.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CREATION OF SOUTHERN DIVISION.**

4       Section 93(a) of title 28, United States Code, is  
5       amended—

6               (1) in paragraph (1) by striking “Grundy,  
7       Kane, Kendall, Lake, La Salle, and Will” and in-  
8       serting “Kane, and Lake”; and

9               (2) by adding at the end the following:

1           “(3) The Southern Division comprises the coun-  
2           ties of Grundy, Kendall, La Salle, and Will.  
3           Court for the Southern Division shall be held at  
4           Joliet.”.

5 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

6           (a) **IN GENERAL.**—This Act and the amendments  
7           made by this Act shall take effect 180 days after the date  
8           of the enactment of this Act.

9           (b) **PENDING CASES NOT AFFECTED.**—This Act and  
10          the amendments made by this Act shall not affect any ac-  
11          tion commenced before the effective date of this Act and  
12          pending in the United States District Court for the North-  
13          ern District of Illinois on such date.

14          (c) **JURIES NOT AFFECTED.**—This Act and the  
15          amendments made by this Act shall not affect the com-  
16          position, or preclude the service, of any grand or petit jury  
17          summoned, empaneled, or actually serving in the Northern  
18          Judicial District of Illinois on the effective date of this  
19          Act.
