A BILL

For the relief of Mary J. Woodard.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That, for the purposes of applying subchapter III of chap-
4 ter 83 of title 5, United States Code, with respect to Mary
5 J. Woodard of Fayetteville, North Carolina, service per-
6 formed by Mary J. Woodard as an employee of the Central
7 Post fund at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, shall be deemed
8 to be service creditable under paragraph (16) of section
9 8332(b) of such title.
