## A BILL

To prohibit the Department of Defense from conducting flight tests of certain missiles that would result in the release of debris outside a designated Department of Defense test range.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Theater Missile  
5 Defense Act of 1994”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON FLIGHT TESTS OF CERTAIN**  
2 **MISSILES.**

3 (a) **LIMITATION.**—The Secretary of Defense may not  
4 conduct a flight test program of theater missile defense  
5 interceptors and sensors if an anticipated result of the  
6 launch of a missile under that test program would be re-  
7 lease of debris in a land area of the United States outside  
8 a designated Department of Defense test range.

9 (b) **DEFINITION OF DEBRIS.**—For purposes of sub-  
10 section (a), the term “debris” does not include particulate  
11 matter that is regulated for considerations of air quality.
