A BILL

To provide for the addition of the Truman Farm Home
to the Harry S Truman National Historic Site in the
State of Missouri.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROPERTY ACQUISITION.**

4 The first section of the Act entitled “An Act to estab-
5 lish the Harry S Truman National Historic Site in the

1 State of Missouri, and for other purposes”, approved May
2 23, 1983 (97 Stat. 193), is amended by adding at the end
3 the following:

4 “(c) The Secretary is further authorized to acquire
5 from Jackson County, Missouri, by donation, the real
6 property commonly referred to as the Truman Farm
7 Home located in Grandview, Jackson County, Missouri,
8 together with associated lands and related structures,
9 comprising approximately 5.2 acres.”

10 “(d) *The Secretary is authorized and directed to pro-*
11 *vide appropriate political subdivisions of the State of Mis-*
12 *souri with technical and planning assistance for the devel-*
13 *opment and implementation of plans, programs, regula-*
14 *tions, or other means for minimizing the adverse effects on*
15 *the Truman Farm Home of the development and use of*
16 *adjacent lands.”.*
