To provide authority to executive departments and agencies to issue rulings respecting application of laws under their jurisdiction.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Regulatory Compliance
- 5 Assistance Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. RULINGS.
- 7 Section 301 of title 5, United States Code, is amend-
- 8 ed—
- 9 (1) by inserting "(a)" before "The head",
- 10 (2) by adding at the end the following:
