AN ACT

- To authorize noncompetitive, career or career-conditional appointments for employees of the Criminal Justice Information Services of the Federal Bureau of Investigation who do not relocate to Clarksburg, West Virginia.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Criminal Justice Infor-
 - 5 mation Services Placement Assistance Act".

1SEC. 2. NONCOMPETITIVE CAREER OR CAREER-CONDI-2TIONAL APPOINTMENTS FOR NONRELO-3CATING EMPLOYEES OF THE CRIMINAL JUS-4TICE INFORMATION SERVICES OF THE FBI.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection 6 (c), an individual described in subsection (b) may be ap-7 pointed noncompetitively, under a career or career-condi-8 tional appointment, to a position in the competitive service 9 if—

10 (1) the individual meets the qualification re11 quirements prescribed by the Office of Personnel
12 Management for the position to which appointed;

(2) the last previous Federal employment of the
individual was as an employee of the Criminal Justice Information Services Division of the Federal
Bureau of Investigation; and

(3) the individual is appointed to such position
within two years after separating from the Criminal
Justice Information Services Division.

20 (b) INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED.—An individual de-21 scribed in this subsection is an individual who—

22	(1) on the date of the enactment of this Act—
23	(A) is an employee of the Criminal Justice
24	Information Services Division of the Federal
25	Bureau of Investigation; and

(B) is serving in an appointed position (i) 1 2 to be relocated from Washington, District of Columbia, to Clarksburg, West Virginia, and 3 (ii) that is excepted by law or regulation from 4 5 the competitive service; and (2) has not relocated with his or her position in 6 7 the Criminal Justice Information Services Division to Clarksburg, West Virginia. 8

9 (c) APPLICATION.—This section does not apply to an 10 individual serving on the date of the enactment of this Act 11 in an appointed position on a temporary or term basis.
