## A BILL

To amend the Public Buildings Act of 1959 to ensure that any lease entered into by a Federal agency for office, meeting, storage, and other space necessary to carry out the functions of the Federal agency shall be subject to the leasing requirements of the Public Buildings Act of 1959.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That section 7 of the Public Buildings Act of 1959 (40  
4       U.S.C. 606) is amended by adding at the end the follow-  
5       ing:

1       “(g) APPLICABILITY TO LEASES OF FEDERAL AGEN-  
2 CIES.—The provisions of this section and sections 11 and  
3 12 of this Act shall apply to any lease of space by a Fed-  
4 eral agency in the same manner and to the same extent  
5 as such provisions would apply if such space were being  
6 leased by the Administrator; except that certain functions  
7 which the Administrator would carry out under such pro-  
8 visions if such space were being leased by the Adminis-  
9 trator shall be carried out by the Federal agency.”.
