A BILL

To grant authority to Guam to give a preference, in awarding contracts, to persons employing citizens, nationals, or permanent resident aliens of the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Guam Labor Pref-
- 5 erence Act''.

1	SEC. 2. AUTHORITY FOR CONTRACT PREFERENCE FOR
2	PERSONS EMPLOYING CITIZENS, NATIONALS,
3	OR PERMANENT RESIDENT ALIENS OF THE
4	UNITED STATES.
5	The Organic Act of Guam (48 U.S.C. 1421 et seq.)
6	is amended by adding at the end the following new section:
7	"SEC. 36. As the laws of Guam may direct, the gov-
8	ernment of Guam may give a preference, in the award of
9	a contract, to persons that demonstrate that not less than
10	a specified percentage of the individuals employed in
11	Guam by the persons are citizens or nationals of the
12	United States or are aliens lawfully admitted to the
13	United States for permanent residence.".
