A BILL

To provide for assistance in the preservation of Taliesin in the State of Wisconsin, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to provide for assistance
- 5 by the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Direc-
- 6 tor of the National Park Service, in the preservation and
- 7 interpretation, for the benefit of present and future gen-
- 8 erations, of—
- 9 (1) the nationally significant land, improve-
- ments, and landscapes in the State of Wisconsin

that comprise the complex known as "Taliesin", 1 which was the home and studio of architect Frank 2 Lloyd Wright from 1911 to 1959 and which was 3 designated as a National Historic Landmark on January 7, 1976; and 5 (2) the adjoining Unity Chapel and Michel's 6 Farm properties. 7 8 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS. 9 As used in this Act: 10 (1) Owner or operator.—The term "owner or operator" means the owner or operator of the 11 12 Taliesin site. (2) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means 13 the Secretary of the Interior. 14 (3) Taliesin site.—The term "Taliesin site" 15 means the properties described in section 1. 16 SEC. 3. COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT AND PLAN. 18 (a) Cooperative Agreement.— 19 (1) IN GENERAL.—In furtherance of the pur-20 pose of this Act, and after approving a comprehensive plan in accordance with subsection (b), the Sec-21 22 retary may enter into one or more cooperative agree-23 ments containing the provisions described in para-24 graph (3) with the owner or operator to provide as-

sistance in accordance with paragraph (2).

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- 1 (2) ASSISTANCE.—Pursuant to a cooperative 2 agreement described in paragraph (1), in accordance 3 with the comprehensive plan described in subsection 4 (b), and for the benefit of the public, the Secretary 5 may provide technical and financial assistance for 6 the protection, restoration, and interpretation of the 7 Taliesin site.
 - (3) Provisions.—Each agreement shall provide that the owner or operator—
 - (A) shall permit public access to the Taliesin site at reasonable times through conducted tours that interpret the culturally significant portions of the Taliesin site; and
 - (B) may make no change or alteration of the Taliesin site that is not consistent with the comprehensive plan.

(b) Comprehensive Plan.—

(1) PREPARATION AND ADOPTION.—As a condition of entering into a cooperative agreement under subsection (a), the owner or operator shall prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan for the continued preservation and public use of the Taliesin site and submit the plan to the Secretary for approval.

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- 1 (2) APPROVAL.—The Secretary shall approve 2 the comprehensive plan if the plan is consistent 3 with, and in furtherance of, the purpose of this Act.
 - (3) AMENDMENT.—The plan may be amended or revised from time to time, but no assistance, financial or otherwise, may be made available pursuant to any cooperative agreement unless the amendment or revision is approved by the Secretary in accordance with this subsection.

10 SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

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- 11 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be appro-12 priated not to exceed \$8,000,000 to carry out this Act. 13 (b) CONDITION.—As a condition of the availability of
- 14 funds pursuant to this Act, the funds must be supple-15 mented with matching non-Federal funds on a one-to-one 16 basis.

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
