## A BILL

To adjust the designation of controlled airspace around the Dallas/Fort Worth Airport, Texas, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF CONTROLLED AIRSPACE.
- 4 (a) GENERAL RULE.—The Administrator of the Fed-
- 5 eral Aviation Administration shall take appropriate action
- 6 to move that portion of the controlled airspace boundary
- 7 around the Dallas/Fort Worth Airport, Texas, that is cur-
- 8 rently at 7 miles from the airport to 8 miles from the air-
- 9 port. The Administrator shall take appropriate action to
- 10 provide for the depiction and publication of such changes.

- 1 (b) Controlled Airspace Boundary.—For pur-
- 2 poses of this section, the term "controlled airspace bound-
- 3 ary" means the boundary around the Dallas/Fort Worth
- 4 Airport, Texas, which separates airspace controlled by the
- 5 Federal Aviation Administration from the surface to
- 6 10,000 feet from the airspace controlled by the Adminis-
- 7 tration around the airport from 2,000 feet to 10,000 feet.
- 8 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 9 Section 1 shall take effect 120 days after the date 0 of the enactment of this Act.

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
