Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. RELIEF FROM FURTHER PREMIUM PAYMENTS

UNDER NSLI PROGRAM.

(a) TERMINATION OF PREMIUM PAYMENTS.—(1)

Notwithstanding any provision of subchapter I of chapter

19 of title 38, United States Code, John T. Monk of Jackson, Mississippi, may not be required to make premium
payments after the date of the enactment of this Act for
the National Service Life Insurance insurance policy for
which such individual was making monthly premium pay-

1	(2) The termination of the requirement for premium
2	payments under paragraph (1) shall not terminate or oth-
3	erwise affect the coverage of John T. Monk of Jackson,
4	Mississippi, under the insurance policy referred to in such
