## A BILL

To oppose Cuba's admission as a member of international financial institutions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. UNITED STATES OPPOSITION TO CUBAN MEM-**  
4 **BERSHIP IN INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL**  
5 **INSTITUTIONS.**

6 The Secretary of the Treasury shall instruct each  
7 United States executive director to an international finan-  
8 cial institution to use the voice and vote of the United  
9 States to oppose the admission of Cuba as a member of  
10 such institution until Cuba holds free and fair internation-

- 2 United States persons for property expropriated in Cuba.
