A BILL

To deny visas to aliens involved with the foreign expropriation of property of United States persons.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. DENIAL OF VISAS TO ALIENS INVOLVED WITH

THE FOREIGN EXPROPRIATION OF PROPERTY OF UNITED STATES PERSONS.

The Secretary of State shall deny a visa to any alien
who is a corporate officer, principal, or shareholder of an
entity which the Secretary of State determines or is informed by competent authority has been involved in the

confiscation, purchase, receipt, or subsequent unauthor-

- 1 ized use or benefit from property of any United States
- 2 person which has been expropriated in a foreign country.
