Mr. DIAZ-BALART introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To deny visas to aliens involved with the foreign expropriation of property of United States persons.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DENIAL OF VISAS TO ALIENS INVOLVED WITH**
4 **THE FOREIGN EXPROPRIATION OF PROP-**
5 **ERTY OF UNITED STATES PERSONS.**

6 The Secretary of State shall deny a visa to any alien
7 who is a corporate officer, principal, or shareholder of an
8 entity which the Secretary of State determines or is in-
9 formed by competent authority has been involved in the
10 confiscation, purchase, receipt, or subsequent unauthor-

- 1 ized use or benefit from property of any United States
- 2 person which has been expropriated in a foreign country.
