## A BILL

To direct the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration to modify the Expanded East Coast Plan for the purpose of reducing aviation noise in the States of New York and New Jersey, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Expanded East Coast  
5       Plan Rollback Act of 1993”.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF AVIATION NOISE IN NEW YORK AND**  
2 **NEW JERSEY.**

3 (a) MODIFICATIONS TO EXPANDED EAST COAST  
4 PLAN.—Not later than eighteen months after the date of  
5 the enactment of this Act, the Administrator of the Fed-  
6 eral Aviation Administration shall modify the Expanded  
7 East Coast Plan for the purpose of reducing aviation noise  
8 in the States of New York and New Jersey and begin im-  
9 plementation of such modifications.

10 (b) USE OF OCEAN ROUTES.—In modifying the Ex-  
11 panded East Coast Plan pursuant to subsection (a), the  
12 Administrator shall to the greatest extent practicable re-  
13 route aircraft using air routes over the States of New York  
14 and New Jersey to air routes over the Atlantic Ocean and,  
15 in cases in which such rerouting is not practicable, reroute  
16 such aircraft to the air routes used before adoption of the  
17 Expanded East Coast Plan.

18 (c) SUPPLEMENTAL EIS.—The Administrator shall  
19 issue a supplemental environmental impact statement pur-  
20 suant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969  
21 to include the effects of modifications to the Expanded  
22 East Coast Plan made pursuant to this section.

23 (d) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than eighteen  
24 months after the date of the enactment of this Act, the  
25 Administrator shall transmit to Congress a report contain-

- 1 ing a description of modifications to the Expanded East
- 2 Coast Plan made pursuant to this section.
