A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Transportation to convey vessels in the National Defense Reserve Fleet to certain nonprofit organizations.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Merchant Marine
- 5 Memorial Enhancement Act of 1993".
- 6 SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE VESSELS.
- 7 (a) AUTHORITY TO CONVEY.—The Secretary of
- 8 Transportation may convey without consideration all
- 9 right, title, and interest of the United States in 2 vessels
- 10 described in subsection (b) to any nonprofit organization

which operates and maintains a Liberty Ship or Victory Ship as a memorial to merchant mariners. 3 (b) VESSELS DESCRIBED.—Vessels which may be conveyed under subsection (a) are vessels which— 5 (1) are in the National Defense Reserve Fleet 6 on the date of the enactment of this Act: 7 (2) are not less than 10,000 displacement tons; 8 (3) have no usefulness to the Government; and 9 (4) are scheduled to be scrapped. 10 (c) CONDITIONS OF CONVEYANCE.—As a condition of conveying any vessel to an organization under subsection 12 (a), the Secretary shall require that before the date of the conveyance the organization enter into an agreement under which the organization shall— 14 15 (1) sell the vessel for scrap purposes; 16 (2) use the proceeds of that scrapping for the 17 purpose of refurbishing and making seaworthy a 18 Liberty Ship or Victory Ship which the organization 19 maintains as a memorial to merchant mariners, to 20 enable the ship to participate in 1994 in commemo-21 rative activities in conjunction with the 50th anni-22 versary of the Normandy invasion; and (3) return to the United States any proceeds of 23 24 scrapping carried out pursuant to paragraph (1)

- which are not used in accordance with paragraph
- $2 \qquad (2).$
- 3 (d) Deposit of Amounts Returned.—Amounts
- 4 returned to the United States pursuant to subsection
- 5 (c)(3) shall be deposited in the Vessel Operations Revolv-
- 6 ing Fund created by the Act of June 2, 1951 (65 Stat.
- 7 59; 46 App. U.S.C. 1241a).
- 8 (e) Delivery of Vessels.—The Secretary shall de-
- 9 liver each vessel conveyed under this section—
- 10 (1) at the place where the vessel is located on
- the date of the approval of the conveyance by the
- 12 Secretary;
- 13 (2) in its condition on that date; and
- 14 (3) without cost to the Government.
- 15 (f) Expiration of Authority to Convey.—The
- 16 authority of the Secretary under this section to convey ves-
- 17 sels shall expire on the date that is 2 years after the date
- 18 of the enactment of this Act.

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
