#### 16 SEC. 209. NATIONAL CENTER FOR EDUCATION STATISTICS.

Paragraph (1) of section 406(f) of the General Edu-cation Provisions Act is amended to read as follows:

"(f)(1) There are authorized to be appropriated
\$79,000,000 for fiscal year 1993 and such sums as may
