3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN TRANSFERS TO RAILROAD RETIRE-**
4 **MENT ACCOUNT.**

5 Subsection (c)(1)(A) of section 224 of the Railroad
6 Retirement Solvency Act of 1983 (relating to section 72(r)
7 revenue increase transferred to certain railroad accounts)
8 is amended by striking “with respect to benefits received
9 before October 1, 1992”.
