## RESOLUTION

Requiring that LEGIS and TLS information be made  
available to the public on the Internet.

1       *Resolved*, That the Committee on House Administra-  
2       tion shall take such action as may be necessary to make  
3       all information from the Legislative Information and Sta-  
4       tus Service (LEGIS) and the Text of Legislation Service  
5       (TLS) available to the public on the Internet. The require-  
6       ment of the preceding sentence shall be carried out not  
7       later than 30 days after the date on which this resolution  
8       is agreed to.
