Mrs. MURRAY introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on Labor and Human Resources

A BILL

To amend the Civil Rights Act of 1991 with respect to
the application of such Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Justice for Wards Cove
5 Workers Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

7 Section 402 of the Civil Rights Act of 1991 (42
8 U.S.C. 1981 note) is amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a) by striking “(a) IN GEN-
10 ERAL.—”; and

1 (2) by striking subsection (b).

2 **SEC. 3. APPLICATION AND CONSTRUCTION.**

3 (a) APPLICATION.—For purposes of determining the
4 application of the amendments made by the Civil Rights
5 Act of 1991, such amendments shall apply to a case that
6 was subject to section 402(b) of the Civil Rights Act of
7 1991 (as in effect on the day before the date of enactment
8 of this Act) in the same manner and to the same extent
9 as such amendments apply to any case brought under title
10 VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42 U.S.C. 2000e et
11 seq.) that was not subject to section 402(b) of the Civil
12 Rights Act of 1991.

13 (b) CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this Act shall be
14 construed to alter, or shall be considered to be evidence
15 of, congressional intent regarding the application of such
16 amendments to any case that was not subject to section
17 402(b) of the Civil Rights Act of 1991.
