1	SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON CASH AWARDS TO CERTAIN
2	FEDERAL OFFICERS.
3	(a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 45 of title 5, United
4	States Code, is amended by inserting after section 4507
5	the following new sections:
6	"§ 4508. Limitation of awards during a Presidential
7	election year
8	"(a) For purposes of this section, the term—
9	"(1) 'Presidential election period' means any
10	period beginning on June 1 in a calendar year in
11	which the popular election of the President occurs,
12	and ending on January 20 following the date of such
13	election; and
14	"(2) 'senior politically appointed officer' means
15	any officer who during a Presidential election period
16	serves—
17	"(A) in a Senior Executive Service position
18	and is not a career appointee as defined under
19	section 3132(a)(4); or
20	"(B) in a position of a confidential or pol-
21	icy-determining character under schedule C of
22	subpart C of part 213 of title 5 of the Code of
23	Federal Regulations.
24	"(b) No senior politically appointed officer may re-
25	ceive an award under the provisions of this subchapter
26	during a Presidential election period.

3	"No officer may receive a cash award under the pro-
4	visions of this subchapter, if such officer serves in an Ex-

9	"(1) an Executive Schedule position under sub-

11	"(2) a position for which the compensation is set

13	chapter II of chapter 53.".
