A BILL

To repeal the provisions of the Service Contract Act of 1965.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Service Contract Act of 1965
5 (41 U.S.C. 351 et seq.) is repealed.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The repeal under subsection
7 (a) shall be effective on and after the date of the enact-
8 ment of this Act and such repealed provisions may not
9 be enforced with regard to any contract entered into
10 before the date of the enactment of this Act.
