## A BILL

For the relief of Olga D. Zhondetskaya.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF CERTAIN NATURALIZATION RE-**  
4 **QUIREMENTS FOR OLGA B. ZHONDETSKAYA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the inability of  
6 Olga D. Zhondetskaya to meet the requirements of section  
7 312 of the Immigration and Nationality Act or the re-  
8 quirements of section 316 of such Act that relate to resi-  
9 dence and physical presence in the United States, if other-  
10 wise qualified, she shall be considered eligible for natu-  
11 ralization and, upon filing an application for naturaliza-  
12 tion and being administered the oath of renunciation and

1 allegiance pursuant to section 337 of such Act, shall be  
2 naturalized as a citizen of the United States.

3 (b) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF  
4 FEES.—Subsection (a) shall apply only if the application  
5 for naturalization is filed with appropriate fees within one  
6 year after the date of the enactment of this Act.
