## A BILL

To reduce certain authorizations for the United States Travel and Tourism Administration, Department of Commerce.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. REDUCTION IN AUTHORIZATION.**

4       Section 304 of the International Travel Act of 1961  
5       (22 U.S.C. 2126) is amended by deleting “not to exceed  
6       \$22,500,000 for fiscal year 1994, not to exceed  
7       \$24,000,000 for fiscal year 1995, and not to exceed  
8       \$26,000,000 for fiscal year 1996” and inserting in lieu  
9       thereof “not to exceed \$11,250,000 for fiscal year 1994,

- 1 not to exceed \$12,000,000 for fiscal year 1995, and not
- 2 to exceed \$13,000,000 for fiscal year 1996”.
