Mr. REID introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To require the Secretary of Agriculture to convey certain lands in Austin, Nevada, to the Austin Historic Mining District Historical Society, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF LANDS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsections (c) and (d),
5 the Secretary of Agriculture (referred to in this Act as
6 the “Secretary”) shall convey, without monetary consider-
7 ation, all right, title, and interest of the United States in
8 and to certain lands located in Austin, Nevada, as de-
9 scribed in subsection (b), to the Austin Historic Mining

1 District Historical Society for use as a museum, or for
2 other public purposes.

3 (b) LAND DESCRIPTION.—The lands referred to in
4 subsection (a) shall—

5 (1) comprise township 19 North, range 44
6 East, section 19, block 38, lots 1 through 16, asses-
7 sor's parcel number 01–147–01, a total of approxi-
8 mately .59 acres; and

9 (2) include improvements on the lands.

10 (c) RESERVATION OF MINERALS.—The Secretary
11 shall include in any deed or other instrument of convey-
12 ance pursuant to subsection (a), a reservation to the Unit-
13 ed States of all minerals underlying the lands referred to
14 in subsection (a).

15 (d) REVERSION TO THE UNITED STATES.—If the
16 lands conveyed by the Secretary pursuant to subsection
17 (a) cease to be operated by the Austin Historic Mining
18 District Historical Society and used as a public museum
19 or for other public purposes, ownership of the lands shall
20 revert to the United States.
