Mr. HATCH (for himself and Mr. BENNETT) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Labor and Human Resources

A BILL

To amend the amount of grants received under chapter 1 of title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Educational Equity
5 Act of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMOUNT OF GRANTS.**

7 The Elementary and Secondary Education Act of
8 1965 (20 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.) is amended—

1 (1) in subparagraph (A) of section 1005(a)(2),
2 by striking the second sentence and inserting “The
3 amount determined under this sentence shall be the
4 average per pupil expenditure in the United
5 States.”; and

6 (2) in each of sections 1201(b), 1221(c), and
7 1241(b), by striking “in the State (or (A) in the
8 case where the average per pupil expenditure in the
9 State is less than 80 percent of the average per
10 pupil expenditure in the United States, of 80 per-
11 cent of the average per pupil expenditure in the
12 United States, or (B) in the case where the average
13 per pupil expenditure in the State is more than 120
14 percent of the average per pupil expenditure in the
15 United States, of 120 percent of average per pupil
16 expenditure in the United States)” and inserting “in
17 the United States”.
