- To amend title 38, United States Code, to require the establishment in the Department of Veterans Affairs of mental illness research, education, and clinical centers, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. MENTAL ILLNESS RESEARCH, EDUCATION, AND 2 CLINICAL CENTERS.

3 (a) IN GENERAL. Subchapter II of chapter 73 of
4 title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
5 end the following:

6 ***§7319. Mental illness research, education, and clini**7 **cal centers**

8 "(a) The purpose of this section is to improve the 9 provision of health-care services and related counseling 10 services to eligible veterans suffering from mental illness, 11 especially mental illness related to service-related condi-12 tions, through research, the education and training of per-13 sonnel, and the development of improved models for fur-14 nishing clinical services.

15 "(b)(1) In order to carry out the purpose of this sec-16 tion, the Secretary, upon the recommendation of the 17 Under Secretary for Health and pursuant to the provi-18 sions of this subsection, shall—

19 <u>"(A)</u> designate not more than five health-care
20 facilities of the Department as the locations for a
21 center of mental illness research, education and
22 training, and clinical activities; and

23 <u>"(B)</u> subject to the appropriation of funds for
24 such purpose, establish and operate such centers at
25 such locations in accordance with this section.

"(2) The Secretary shall designate at least one facil ity under paragraph (1) not later than January 1, 1994.
 "(3) The Secretary, upon the recommendation of the
 Under Secretary for Health, shall ensure that the facilities
 designated for centers under paragraph (1) are located in
 various geographic regions.

7 "(4) The Secretary may not designate any health-8 care facility as a location for a center under paragraph 9 (1) unless the Secretary, upon the recommendation of the 10 Under Secretary for Health, determines that the facility 11 has developed (or may reasonably be anticipated to de-12 velop)—

"(A) an arrangement with an accredited medi-13 14 cal school which provides education and training in 15 psychiatry and with which the facility is affiliated under which arrangement residents receive education 16 17 and training in psychiatry through regular rotation 18 through the facility so as to provide such residents 19 with training in the diagnosis and treatment of men-20 tal illness:

21 "(B) an arrangement with an accredited grad-22 uate school of psychology which provides education 23 and training in clinical or counseling psychology, or 24 both, and with which the facility is affiliated under 25 which arrangement students receive education and training in clinical or counseling psychology, or both,
 through regular rotation through the facility so as to
 provide such students with training in the diagnosis
 and treatment of mental illness;

5 ^{((C)} an arrangement under which nursing, so-6 cial work, or other allied health personnel receive 7 training and education in mental health care 8 through regular rotation through the facility;

9 "(D) the ability to attract scientists who have 10 demonstrated creativity and achievement in research 11 into the causes, treatment, and prevention of mental 12 illness and into models for furnishing care and treat-13 ment to veterans suffering from mental illness;

14 "(E) a policymaking advisory committee com-15 posed of appropriate mental health-care and re-16 search personnel of the facility and of the affiliated 17 school or schools to advise the directors of the facil-18 ity and the center on policy matters pertaining to 19 the activities of the center during the period of the 20 operation of the center; and

21 "(F) the capability to conduct effectively evaluations of the activities of the center.

23 "(c) Clinical and scientific investigation activities at
24 each center may compete for the award of funding from
25 amounts appropriated for the Department of Veterans Af-

fairs medical and prosthetics research account and shall
 receive priority in the award of funding from such account
 insofar as funds are awarded to projects and activities re lating mental illness.

5 "(d) The Under Secretary for Health shall ensure 6 that research activities carried out through centers estab-7 lished under subsection (b)(1) include an appropriate em-8 phasis on the psychosocial dimension of mental illness and 9 on proposals of means of furnishing care and treatment 10 to veterans suffering from mental illness.

11 "(e) The Under Secretary for Health shall ensure that useful information produced by the research, edu-12 cation and training, and clinical activities of the centers 13 established under subsection (b)(1) is disseminated 14 throughout the Veterans Health Administration through 15 the development of programs of continuing medical and 16 related education provided through regional medical edu-17 cation centers under subchapter VI of chapter 74 of this 18 title and through other means. 19

20 "(f) The official within the Central Office of the Vet21 erans Health Administration responsible for mental health
22 and behavioral sciences matters shall be responsible for
23 supervising the operation of the centers established pursu24 ant to subsection (b)(1).

"(g)(1) There are authorized to be appropriated for
 the Department of Veterans Affairs for the basic support
 of the research and education and training activities of
 the centers established pursuant to subsection (b)(1) the
 following:

6 <u>"(A)</u> \$3,125,000 for fiscal year 1994.

7 <u>"(B) \$6,250,000 for each of fiscal years 1995</u>
8 through 1997.

9 "(2) In addition to the funds available under the au-10 thorization of appropriations in paragraph (1), the Under Secretary for Health shall allocate to such centers from 11 other funds appropriated generally for the Department of 12 Veterans Affairs medical care account and the Depart-13 ment of Veterans Affairs medical and prosthetics research 14 account such amounts as the Under Secretary for Health 15 determines appropriate in order to carry out the purposes 16 of this section.". 17

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT. The table of sections
at the beginning of chapter 73 of such title is amended
by adding at the end of the matter relating to subchapter
H the following:

"7319. Mental illness research, education, and clinical centers.".

(c) REPORTS. Not later than February 1 of each of
1995, 1996, and 1997, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs
shall submit to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of
the Senate and House of Representatives a report on the

SECTION 1. MENTAL ILLNESS RESEARCH, EDUCATION, AND
 CLINICAL CENTERS.
 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 73 of title
 38, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end
 the following:

6 *"§ 7319. Mental illness research, education, and clini-*7 *cal centers*

8 "(a) The purpose of this section is to improve the provision of health-care services and related counseling services 9 to eligible veterans suffering from mental illness, especially 10 mental illness related to service-related conditions, through 11 research (including research on improving mental health 12 service facilities of the Department and on improving the 13 delivery of mental health services by the Department), edu-14 cation and training of personnel, and the development of 15 improved models and systems for the furnishing of mental 16 health services by the Department. 17

''(b)(1) In order to carry out the purpose of this section, the Secretary, upon the recommendation of the Under
Secretary for Health and pursuant to the provisions of this
subsection, shall—

"(A) designate not more than five health-care facilities of the Department as the locations for a center
of research on mental health services, on the use by
the Department of specific models for furnishing such
services, on education and training, and on the devel-

1	opment and implementation of innovative clinical ac-
2	tivities and systems of care with respect to the deliv-
3	ery of such services by the Department; and
4	"(B) subject to the appropriation of funds for
5	such purpose, establish and operate such centers at
6	such locations in accordance with this section.
7	"(2) The Secretary shall designate at least one facility
8	under paragraph (1) not later than January 1, 1994.
9	"(3) The Secretary shall, upon the recommendation of
10	the Under Secretary for Health, ensure that the facilities
11	designated for centers under paragraph (1) are located in
12	various geographic regions.
13	"(4) The Secretary may not designate any health-care
14	facility as a location for a center under paragraph (1) un-
15	less—
16	"(A) the peer review panel established under
17	paragraph (5) has determined under that paragraph
18	that the proposal submitted by such facility as a loca-
19	tion for a new center under this subsection is among
20	those proposals which have met the highest competi-
21	tive standards of scientific and clinical merit; and
22	"(B) the Secretary, upon the recommendation of
23	the Under Secretary for Health, determines that the
24	facility has developed (or may reasonably be antici-
25	pated to develop)—

1	''(i) an arrangement with an accredited
2	medical school which provides education and
3	training in psychiatry and with which the facil-
4	ity is affiliated under which arrangement resi-
5	dents receive education and training in psychia-
6	try through regular rotation through the facility
7	so as to provide such residents with training in
8	the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness;
9	"(ii) an arrangement with an accredited
10	graduate school of psychology under which ar-
11	rangement students receive education and train-
12	ing in clinical, counseling, or professional psy-
13	chology through regular rotation through the fa-
14	cility so as to provide such students with train-
15	ing in the diagnosis and treatment of mental ill-
16	ness;
17	"(iii) an arrangement under which nursing,
18	social work, or allied health personnel receive
19	training and education in mental health care
20	through regular rotation through the facility;
21	"(iv) the ability to attract scientists who
22	have demonstrated creativity and achievement in
23	research—

- *"(I) into the evaluation of innovative* 1 2 approaches to the design of mental health services: or 3 "(II) into the causes, prevention, and 4 5 treatment of mental illness: "(v) a policymaking advisory committee 6 7 composed of appropriate mental health-care and research personnel of the facility and of the af-8 filiated school or schools to advise the directors 9 10 of the facility and the center on policy matters pertaining to the activities of the center during 11 the period of the operation of the center; and 12 "(vi) the capability to evaluate effectively 13 14 the activities of the center, including activities relating to the evaluation of specific efforts to 15 improve the quality and effectiveness of mental 16 17 health services provided by the Department at or 18 through individual facilities. 19 "(5)(A) In order to provide advice to assist the Under Secretary for Health and the Secretary to carry out their 20 responsibilities under this section, the official within the 21
- 22 Central Office of the Veterans Health Administration re23 sponsible for mental health and behavioral sciences matters
 24 shall establish a panel to assess the scientific and clinical

merit of proposals that are submitted to the Secretary for
 the establishment of new centers under this subsection.

3 "(B) The membership of the panel shall consist of ex4 perts in the fields of mental health research, education and
5 training, and clinical care. Members of the panel shall serve
6 as consultants to the Department for a period of no longer
7 than six months.

8 "(C) The panel shall review each proposal submitted 9 to the panel by the official referred to in subparagraph (A) 10 and shall submit its views on the relative scientific and 11 clinical merit of each such proposal to that official.

12 "(D) The panel shall not be subject to the Federal Ad13 visory Committee Act (5 U.S.C. App.).

14 "(c) Clinical and scientific investigation activities at 15 each center may compete for the award of funding from 16 amounts appropriated for the Department of Veterans Af-17 fairs medical and prosthetics research account and shall re-18 ceive priority in the award of funding from such account 19 insofar as funds are awarded to projects and activities re-20 lating to mental illness.

''(d) The Under Secretary for Health shall ensure that
at least three centers designated under subsection (b)(1)(A)
emphasize research into means of improving the quality of
care for veterans suffering from mental illness through the

development of community-based alternatives to institu tional treatment for such illness.

3 "(e) The Under Secretary for Health shall ensure that useful information produced by the research, education and 4 training, and clinical activities of the centers established 5 under subsection (b)(1) is disseminated throughout the Vet-6 erans Health Administration through publications and 7 through programs of continuing medical and related edu-8 cation provided through regional medical education centers 9 under subchapter VI of chapter 74 of this title and through 10 11 other means.

12 "(f) The official within the Central Office of the Veter-13 ans Health Administration responsible for mental health 14 and behavioral sciences matters shall be responsible for su-15 pervising the operation of the centers established pursuant 16 to subsection (b)(1).

17 "(g)(1) There are authorized to be appropriated for the
18 Department of Veterans Affairs for the basic support of the
19 research and education and training activities of the centers
20 established pursuant to subsection (b)(1) the following:

21 *"(A) \$3,125,000 for fiscal year 1994.*

22 "(B) \$6,250,000 for each of fiscal years 1995
23 through 1997.

24 *"(2) In addition to the funds available under the au-*25 thorization of appropriations in paragraph (1), the Under

Secretary for Health shall allocate to such centers from
 other funds appropriated generally for the Department of
 Veterans Affairs medical care account and the Department
 of Veterans Affairs medical and prosthetics research account
 such amounts as the Under Secretary for Health determines
 appropriate in order to carry out the purposes of this sec tion.".

8 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections at 9 the beginning of chapter 73 of such title is amended by add-10 ing at the end of the matter relating to subchapter II the 11 following:

"7319. Mental illness research, education, and clinical centers.".

12 (c) REPORTS.—Not later than February 1 of each of 1995, 1996, and 1997, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs 13 shall submit to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the 14 Senate and House of Representatives a report on the status 15 and activities during the previous fiscal year of the mental 16 illness, research, education, and clinical centers established 17 pursuant to section 7319 of title 38, United States Code 18 (as added by subsection (a)). Each such report shall contain 19 the following: 20

- 21 *(1) A description of—*
- 22 (A) the activities carried out at each center
- 23 *and the funding provided for such activities;*
- 24 (B) the advances made at each center in re25 search, education and training, and clinical ac-

tivities relating to mental illness in veterans; 1 2 and 3 (C) the actions taken by the Under Secretary for Health pursuant to subsection (d) of 4 5 such section (as so added) to disseminate useful information derived from such activities through-6 out the Veterans Health Administration. 7 (2) The Secretary's evaluations of the effective-8 ness of the centers in fulfilling the purposes of the cen-9 10 ters. (d) TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.—Section 7314(d)(1) of 11 such title is amended by striking out "the Chief Medical 12 Director" and inserting in lieu thereof "the Under Sec-13 14 retary for Health".
