A BILL

To clarify the treatment of the Centennial Bridge, Rock
Island, Illinois, under title 23, United States Code, and
for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF CENTENNIAL BRIDGE, ROCK**
4 **ISLAND, ILLINOIS, AGREEMENT.**

5 For purposes of section 129(a)(6) of title 23, United
6 States Code, the agreement concerning the Centennial
7 Bridge, Rock Island, Illinois, entered into under the Act
8 entitled “An Act authorizing the city of Rock Island, Illi-
9 nois, or its assigns, to construct, maintain, and operate

1 a toll bridge across the Mississippi River at or near Rock
2 Island, Illinois, and to a place at or near the city of Dav-
3 enport, Iowa'', approved March 18, 1938 (52 Stat. 110,
4 chapter 48), shall be treated as if the agreement had been
5 entered into under section 129 of title 23, United States
6 Code, as in effect on December 17, 1991, and may be
7 modified in accordance with section 129(a)(6) of such
8 title.
