A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Navy to transfer, without regard to the required waiting period, an obsolete naval vessel to the United States Naval Shipbuilding Museum, Quincy, Massachusetts, upon making certain determinations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF WAITING PERIOD TO TRANSFER**

4 **VESSEL.**

5 Notwithstanding subsection (c)(2) of section 7308 of
6 title 10, United States Code, the Secretary of the Navy
7 may transfer under such section the obsolete heavy cruiser

1 U.S.S. Salem to the United States Naval Shipbuilding
2 Museum in Quincy, Massachusetts, immediately upon the
3 Secretary's determination that—

4 (1) such cruiser is in environmentally safe con-
5 dition as determined by appropriate tests, including
6 tests administered by the Environmental Protection
7 Agency; and

8 (2) such Museum has adequate financial re-
9 sources to maintain such cruiser in a condition satis-
10 factory to the Department of the Navy.
