**AMENDMENT**

***In the House of Representatives, U. S.,***

*November 23 (legislative day, November 22), 1993.*

*Resolved, That the bill from the Senate (S. 1732) entitled “An Act to extend arbitration under the provisions of chapter 44 of title 28, United States Code, and for other purposes”, do pass with the following*

**AMENDMENT:**

Add the following after section 1:

1 ***SEC. 2. TREATMENT OF EXPIRED PROVISIONS.***

2 *Chapter 44 of title 28, United States Code, and the*  
3 *item relating to that chapter in the table of chapters at the*  
4 *beginning of part III of such title, shall be effective on or*  
5 *after the date of the enactment of this Act as if such chapter*  
6 *and item had not been repealed by section 906 of the Judi-*  
7 *cial Improvements and Access to Justice Act, as such section*  
8 *was in effect on the day before the date of the enactment*  
9 *of this Act.*
