1 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
2 905 of the Judicial Improvements and Access to Justice
3 Act (28 U.S.C. 651 note; Public Law 100–702; 102 Stat.
4 4664) is amended in the first sentence by striking out “4”
5 and inserting in lieu thereof “7”.

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
