## A BILL

To amend the Social Security Act to extend for 3 years the provision for compensation of qualified organizations serving as representative payees, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Representative Payee  
5 Amendments of 1993”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMPENSATION FOR QUALIFIED ORGANIZATIONS**

7 **SERVING AS REPRESENTATIVE PAYEES.**

8 (a) TITLE II.—

1           (1) EXTENSION.—Section 205(j)(4)(D) of the  
2 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 405(j)(4)(D)) is  
3 amended by striking “July 1, 1994” and inserting  
4 “July 1, 1997”.

5           (2) ELIGIBILITY OF ORGANIZATIONS.—Section  
6 205(j)(4)(B)(iii) of such Act (42 U.S.C.  
7 405(j)(4)(B)) is amended by striking “on October 1,  
8 1988” and inserting “at least 1 year before the com-  
9 mencement of services as a representative payee of  
10 any such individual”.

11 (b) TITLE XVI.—

12           (1) EXTENSION.—Section 1631(a)(2)(D)(iv) of  
13 the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.  
14 1383(a)(2)(D)(iv)) is amended by striking “July 1,  
15 1994” and inserting “July 1, 1997”.

16           (2) ELIGIBILITY OF ORGANIZATIONS.—Section  
17 1631(a)(2)(D)(ii)(II)(cc) of such Act (42 U.S.C.  
18 1383(a)(2)(D)(ii)(II)) is amended by striking “on  
19 October 1, 1988” and inserting “at least 1 year be-  
20 fore the commencement of services as a representa-  
21 tive payee of any such individual”.

22 (c) EFFECTIVE DATES.—

23           (1) EXTENSION.—The amendments made by  
24 subsections (a)(1) and (b)(1) shall take effect on  
25 July 1, 1994.

1           (2) ELIGIBILITY OF ORGANIZATIONS.—The  
2           amendments made by subsections (a)(2) and (b)(2)  
3           shall take effect on the date of the enactment of this  
4           Act, and shall only apply with respect to—

5                   (A) certifications of payment of benefits  
6                   under title II of the Social Security Act to rep-  
7                   resentative payees made on or after such date;  
8                   and

9                   (B) provisions for payment of benefits  
10                  under title XVI of such Act to representative  
11                  payees made on or after such date.
