AN ACT

To provide early out authority for Forest Service employees.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 Section 1.—Forest Service Separation Pay.—
- 4 (a) In order to avoid or minimize the need for involuntary
- 5 separations, effective for the period beginning upon the
- 6 date of enactment of this Act through and including Sep-
- 7 tember 30, 1994, the Secretary of Agriculture, under such
- 8 regulations and subject to such conditions as the Secretary
- 9 of Agriculture may prescribe, shall have authority to offer
- 10 separation pay to employees of the Forest Service to the
- 11 same extent the Secretary of Defense is authorized to offer

- 1 separation pay to employees of a defense agency in section
- 2 5597 of title 5, United States Code.
- 3 (b) In the event that an authority is enacted to offer
- 4 separation pay or a voluntary separation incentive similar
- 5 to such section 5597 of title 5, United States Code, but
- 6 applicable to employees in the executive branch generally,
- 7 the authority under subsection (a) shall terminate.
- 8 (c) Such payments may be made to employees who
- 9 agree, during a continuous 90 day period designated by
- 10 the agency head, beginning no earlier than the date of en-
- 11 actment of this Act and ending no later than September
- 12 30, 1994, to separate from service with the agency, wheth-
- 13 er by retirement or resignation.
- 14 (d) An employee who has received a voluntary separa-
- 15 tion incentive under this section and accepts employment
- 16 with the Government of the United States within 5 years
- 17 of the date of the separation on which payment of the in-
- 18 centive is based shall be required to repay the entire
- 19 amount of the incentive to the agency that paid the incen-
- 20 tive.

- 1 (e) Total outlays by the Forest Service pursuant to
- 2 the cooperative work trust funds accounts (12-8028-0-
- 3 7–302) shall not exceed \$271,668,000 in fiscal year 1994.
