7 designated as the “Daniel Webster Senate Page Resi-
8 dence”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the “Daniel Webster Senate Page Resi-
6 dence”.

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
