To suspend temporarily the duty on certain PVC rain slickers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN PVC RAIN**
4 **SLICKERS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new subheading:

“	9902.39.20	Plastic rainwear, including jackets, coats, ponchos, parkas, and slickers; featuring an outer shell of polyvinyl chloride plastic with or without attached hoods, valued not over \$10 per unit (provided for in sub-heading 3926.20.50)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/98	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section applies with respect to goods entered, or with-
3 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the
4 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
