## A BILL

To amend the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act to improve the administration of claims and obligations of the Farmers Home Administration, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Farmers Home Admin-  
5       istration Improvement Act of 1994”.

1 **SEC. 2. DELINQUENT FARMERS HOME ADMINISTRATION**  
2 **OBLIGATIONS.**

3 Section 331 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural De-  
4 velopment Act (7 U.S.C. 1981) is amended by adding at  
5 the end the following new subsection:

6 “(c) The Secretary may use for the prosecution or  
7 defense of any claim or obligation described in subsection  
8 (b)(5) the Attorney General, the General Counsel of the  
9 Department of Agriculture, or a private attorney who has  
10 entered into a contract with the Secretary.”
