A BILL

To provide duty-free privileges to participants in, and other individuals associated with, the 1994 World Rowing Championships.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DUTY-FREE ENTRIES.**

4 Subchapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tar-
5 iff Schedule of the United States is amended by inserting
6 in numerical sequence the following new heading:

“	9902.98.04	Any of the following articles not intended for commercial use; personal effects of participants in, or officials of, or accredited members of the delegation to, the 1994 World Rowing Championships; personal effects of persons who are immediate family members of, or servants to, any of the foregoing persons; equipment intended for use in connection with such Championships; and such other related articles as may be allowed by the Secretary of the Treasury	Free	No change	Free	On or before 10/30/94	”.

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 (a) GENERAL RULE.—The amendment made by this
3 Act applies to articles entered, or withdrawn from ware-
4 house for consumption, on or after the 15th day after the
5 date of the enactment of this Act.

6 (b) RELIQUIDATION.—Notwithstanding section 514
7 of the Tariff Act of 1930 or any other provision of law,
8 upon proper request filed with the Customs Service on or
9 before the date that is 180 days after the date of the en-
10 actment of this Act, any entry, or withdrawal from ware-
11 house for consumption, of an article described in heading
12 9902.98.04 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
13 United States (as added by section 1) that occurred—

14 (1) after December 31, 1993, and before the
15 date which is 15 days after the date of the enact-
16 ment of this Act, and

1 (2) with respect to which there would have been
2 no duty if the amendment made by section 1 applied
3 to such entry or withdrawal,
4 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such amend-
5 ment applied to such entry or withdrawal.
