A BILL

To improve the administration of the Women's Rights National Historical Park in the State of New York, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL PROPERTIES.**

4 Section 1601(c) of Public Law 96-607 (16 U.S.C.
5 410ll) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “initially” in the second sen-
2 tence;

3 (2) in paragraph (8), by striking “and” the last
4 place it appears;

5 (3) in paragraph (9) by striking the period and
6 inserting a semicolon; and

7 (4) by adding at the end the following new
8 paragraphs:

9 “~~(10) not to exceed 1 acre, plus improvements,~~
10 as determined by the Secretary, in Seneca Falls for
11 development of a maintenance facility;

12 “~~(11) dwelling, 1 Seneca Street, Seneca Falls;~~

13 “~~(12) dwelling, 10 Seneca Street, Seneca Falls;~~

14 “~~(13) parcels adjacent to Wesleyan Chapel~~
15 Block, including Clinton Street, Fall Street, and
16 Mynderse Street, Seneca Falls; and

17 “~~(14) dwelling, 12 East Williams Street, Water-~~
18 loo.”.

19 **SEC. 2. MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS.**

20 Section 1601 of Public Law 96-607 (16 U.S.C.
21 4101) is amended—

22 (1) in subsection (g), by adding at the end the
23 following new sentence: “Funds available to the Sec-
24 retary for the purposes of the park shall be available
25 to establish and administer within the park edu-

1 cation and research facilities and programs on the
 2 history of women's rights pursuant to cooperative
 3 agreements with appropriate public or private
 4 entities.';

5 (2) in paragraph (5) of subsection (h), by strik-
 6 ing "ten years" and inserting "25 years"; and

7 (3) in subsection (i)—

8 (A) by striking "\$700,000" and inserting
 9 "\$1,500,000"; and

10 (B) by striking "\$500,000" and inserting
 11 and "\$15,000,000".

12 **SECTION 1. INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL PROPERTIES.**

13 *Section 1601(c) of Public Law 96-607 (16 U.S.C.*
 14 *41011) is amended to read as follows: "To carry out the*
 15 *purposes of this section there is hereby established the Wom-*
 16 *en's Rights National Historical Park (hereinafter in this*
 17 *section referred to as the "park"). The park shall consist*
 18 *of the following designated sites in Seneca Falls and Water-*
 19 *loo, New York:*

20 (1) *Stanton House, 32 Washington Street, Sen-*
 21 *eca Falls;*

22 (2) *dwelling, 30 Washington Street, Seneca*
 23 *Falls;*

24 (3) *dwelling, 34 Washington Street, Seneca*
 25 *Falls;*

1 “(4) lot, 26–28 Washington Street, Seneca Falls;

2 “(5) former Wesleyan Chapel, 126 Fall Street,
3 Seneca Falls;

4 “(6) theater, 128 Fall Street, Seneca Falls;

5 “(7) McClintock House, 16 East Williams Street,
6 Waterloo;

7 “(8) Hunt House, 401 East Williams Street,
8 Waterloo;

9 “(9) not to exceed 1 acre, plus improvements, as
10 determined by the Secretary, in Seneca Falls for de-
11 velopment of a maintenance facility;

12 “(10) dwelling, 1 Seneca Street, Seneca Falls;

13 “(11) dwelling, 10 Seneca Street, Seneca Falls;

14 “(12) parcels adjacent to Wesleyan Chapel Block,
15 including Clinton Street, Fall Street, and Mynderse
16 Street, Seneca Falls; and

17 “(13) dwelling, 12 East Williams Street, Water-
18 loo.”.

19 **SEC. 2. MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS.**

20 Section 1601 of Public Law 96–607 (16 U.S.C. 4101l)
21 is amended by redesignating subsection (i) as “(i)(1)” and
22 inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:

23 “(2) In addition to those sums appropriated prior to
24 the date of enactment of this paragraph for land acquisition

1 *and development, there is hereby authorized to be appro-*
2 *priated an additional \$2,000,000.”.*
