3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF AUTHORIZATION.**

4 ~~Section 502~~ *Subsection* (h) of the Indian Environ-

1 *U.S.C. 4368b(h)* is amended by striking “and 1994” and  
2 inserting “, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000,  
3 2001, 2002, and 2003”.

4 ***SEC. 2. REPORT TO CONGRESS.***

5 *The Indian Environmental General Assistance Pro-*  
6 *gram Act of 1992 (42 U.S.C. 4368b) is amended by adding*  
7 *at the end the following:*

8 “(i) *REPORT TO CONGRESS.*—*The Administrator shall*  
9 *transmit an annual report to the Congress describing—*

10 “(1) *which Indian tribes or intertribal consortia*  
11 *have been granted approval by the Administrator*  
12 *pursuant to law to enforce certain environmental*  
13 *laws;*

14 “(2) *the effectiveness of any such enforcement;*  
15 *and*

16 “(3) *any conflicts that may have arisen regard-*  
17 *ing private property due to such enforcement.”.*
