## **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

- 1 Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives
- 2 concurring), That effective January 5, 1993, the joint
- 3 committee created by S. Con. Res. 102 of the One Hun-
- 4 dred Second Congress, to make the necessary arrange-
- 5 ments for the inauguration, is hereby continued with the
- 6 same power and authority. The joint committee may ac-
- 7 cept gifts and donations of goods and services to carry
- 8 out its responsibilities.
- 9 SEC. 2. That effective from January 5, 1993, the pro-
- 10 visions of S. Con. Res. 103 of the One Hundred Second
- 11 Congress, to authorize the rotunda of the United States
- 12 Capitol to be used in connection with the proceedings and
- 13 ceremonies for the inauguration of the President-elect and

- 1 the Vice President-elect of the United States, are hereby
- 2 continued with the same power and authority.
