- 5 cordance with this resolution, it stand adjourned until
- 6 12:00 noon on Monday, April 19, 1993, or until 12:00
- 7 noon on the second day after Members are notified to reas-
- 8 semble pursuant to section 2 of this resolution, whichever
- 9 occurs first.
- SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
- 11 Speaker of the House, acting jointly after consultation
- 12 with the Minority Leader of the Senate and the Minority
- 13 Leader of the House, shall notify the Members of the Sen-
- 14 ate and the House, respectively, to reassemble whenever,
- 15 in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
