## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To waive the provisions of the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1970 which require the adjournment of the House and Senate by July 31.

1        *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2        *concurring)*, That notwithstanding the provisions of sec-  
3        tion 132(a) of the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946  
4        (2 U.S.C. 198), as amended by section 461 of the Legisla-  
5        tive Reorganization Act of 1970 (Public Law 91-510; 84  
6        Stat. 1193), the Senate and the House of Representatives  
7        shall not adjourn for a period in excess of three days, or  
8        adjourn sine die, until both Houses of Congress have  
9        adopted a concurrent resolution providing either for an ad-

- 1 journeyment (in excess of three days) to a day certain, or
- 2 for adjournment sine die.
