which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To authorize the printing of a new annotated edition of Glenn Brown's "History of the United States Capitol", originally published in two volumes in 1900 and 1903, prepared under the auspices of the Architect of the Capitol.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That there shall be printed as a Senate docu-
3 ment, the book entitled "Glenn Brown's History of the
4 United States Capitol," as prepared under the auspices
5 of the Architect of the Capitol, with support from the
6 United States Capitol Preservation Commission and the
7 United States Capitol Historical Society.

1 SEC. 2. Such document shall include illustrations,
2 and shall be in such style, form, manner, and binding as
3 directed by the Joint Committee on Printing after con-
4 sultation with the Secretary of the Senate.

5 SEC. 3. In addition to the usual number of copies,
6 there shall be printed—

7 (1) 6,500 copies for the use of the Senate and
8 the House of Representatives, to be allocated as de-
9 termined jointly by the Secretary of the Senate and
10 the Clerk of the House of Representatives; or

11 (2) such number of copies as does not exceed
12 a total production and printing cost of \$112,265.
