- 5 of the Capitol.
- 6 SEC. 2. Such document shall include illustrations and
- 7 shall be in such style, form, manner, and binding as di-
- 8 rected by the Joint Committee on Printing after consulta-
- 9 tion with the Secretary of the Senate.

SEC. 3. In addition to the usual number of copies,
there shall be printed—

(1) 50,000 copies for the use of the Commission
on the Bicentennial of the United States Capitol; or

(2) such number of copies as does not exceed
a total production and printing cost of \$59,697.
