- 7 SEC. 2. The document referred to in the first section
- 8 shall be—
- 9 (1) published under the supervision of the Sec-
- retary of the Senate; and

1	(2) in such style, form, manner, and binding as
2	directed by the Joint Committee on Printing, after
3	consultation with the Secretary of the Senate.
4	The document shall include illustrations.
5	SEC. 3. In addition to the usual number of copies
6	of the document, there shall be printed the lesser of—
7	(1) 5,000 copies for the use of the Secretary of
8	the Senate; or
9	(2) such number of copies as does not exceed
10	a total production and printing cost of \$47,864.
