Mr. REID submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To authorize printing of Senator Robert C. Byrd's Addresses to the United States Senate on the History of Roman Constitutionalism.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That there shall be printed as a Senate docu-
3 ment "U.S. Senator Robert C. Byrd's Addresses to the
4 United States Senate on the History of Roman Constitu-
5 tionalism", delivered between May 5, 1993 and October
6 18, 1993.

7 SEC. 2. The document referred to in the first section
8 shall be—

9 (1) published under the supervision of the Sec-
10 retary of the Senate; and

1 (2) in such style, form, manner, and binding as
2 directed by the Joint Committee on Printing, after
3 consultation with the Secretary of the Senate.

4 The document shall include illustrations.

5 SEC. 3. In addition to the usual number of copies
6 of the document, there shall be printed the lesser of—

7 (1) 5,000 copies for the use of the Secretary of
8 the Senate; or

9 (2) such number of copies as does not exceed
10 a total production and printing cost of \$47,864.
