## SECTION 1. APPOINTMENT OF EXECUTIVE SECRETARY FOR THE UNITED STATES CAPITOL PRESERVA TION COMMISSION.

4 Section 801(e) of the Arizona-Idaho Conservation Act 5 of 1988 (40 U.S.C. 188a(e); Public Law 100–696; 102 6 Stat. 4608) is amended by inserting at the end thereof 7 "The co-chairmen of the Commission shall jointly appoint 8 an executive secretary of the Commission from public or 9 private life to serve without compensation and to advise 10 and assist the Commission at the direction of the co-chair-11 men.".
