JOINT RESOLUTION

To provide for the appointment of an executive secretary for the United States Capitol Preservation Commission, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. APPOINTMENT OF EXECUTIVE SECRETARY FOR**
4 **THE UNITED STATES CAPITOL PRESERVA-**
5 **TION COMMISSION.**

6 Section 801(e) of the Arizona-Idaho Conservation Act
7 of 1988 (40 U.S.C. 188a(e); Public Law 100–696; 102
8 Stat. 4608) is amended by inserting at the end thereof
9 “The co-chairmen of the Commission shall jointly appoint
10 an executive secretary of the Commission from public or
11 private life to serve without compensation and to advise

1 and assist the Commission at the direction of the co-
2 chairmen.”.
