## JOINT RESOLUTION

To designate the weeks beginning April 18, 1993, and April 17, 1994, each as “National Organ and Tissue Donor Awareness Week”.

Whereas a new patient is added to the national patient waiting list for an organ transplant every 20 minutes;

Whereas thousands of lives are saved or significantly improved annually by organ and tissue transplantation; and

Whereas increasing the number of transplantable organs and tissues would save American taxpayers millions of dollars:

Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the weeks beginning April 18, 1993, and April 17,  
4       1994, are each designated “National Organ and Tissue  
5       Donor Awareness Week”, and the President is authorized  
6       and requested to issue a proclamation calling upon the  
7       people of the United States to observe such weeks with  
8       appropriate programs, ceremonies, and activities.
