Extending the provisions of Senate Resolution 105 of the One Hundred First Congress, relating to the Senate Arms Control Observer Group, and for other purposes.

Mr. MITCHELL (for himself and Mr. DOLE) submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

Extending the provisions of Senate Resolution 105 of the One Hundred First Congress, relating to the Senate Arms Control Observer Group, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That (a) the provisions of Senate Resolu-
2 tion 105 of the One Hundred First Congress (agreed to
3 April 13, 1989) (as extended by Senate Resolution 358
4 of the One Hundred First Congress (agreed to October
5 28, 1990), and further extended by Senate Resolution 365
6 of the One Hundred Second Congress (agreed to October
7 8, 1992)), shall remain in effect until December 31, 1994.

8 (b) Section 2(b) of Senate Resolution 105 of the One
9 Hundred First Congress is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1)—

2 (A) by inserting “or more” after “one”
3 each place it appears; and

4 (B) by striking “staff member” each place
5 it appears and inserting in lieu thereof “staff
6 members”;

7 (2) by striking paragraph (2);

8 (3) by redesignating paragraphs (3), (4) and
9 (5) as paragraphs (2), (3) and (4), respectively; and

10 (4) in paragraph (2) (as redesignated), by strik-
11 ing “or secretary” each place it appears.

12 (c) Section 2(c) of Senate Resolution 105 of the One
13 Hundred First Congress is amended by striking the first
14 sentence and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “The
15 Majority Leader and Minority Leader may each designate
16 one or more staff members to be responsible to the respec-
17 tive Leaders.”.

18 (d) Section 3 of Senate Resolution 105 of the One
19 Hundred First Congress is amended—

20 (1) in subsection (a)—

21 (A) by striking “\$600,000” and inserting
22 in lieu thereof “\$380,000”; and

23 (B) by striking the period at the end there-
24 of and inserting a comma and the following:

25 “except that not more than \$100,000 shall be

1 available for each Administrative Cochairman
2 and the Cochairman's staff, and not more than
3 \$60,000 shall be available for each Cochairman
4 of the Group who is not an Administrative Co-
5 chairman and the Cochairman's staff"; and

6 (2) in subsection (b), by striking "\$300,000"
7 and inserting in lieu thereof "\$200,000".

8 (e) This resolution, and the amendments made by
9 this resolution, shall be deemed to have become effective
10 as of March 30, 1993.
